

#### Report

Being in the midst of lock down due to pandemic, the session was conducted via ZOOM Meeting.

The panel consisted of Four volunteers Ms.Saisaranyya Menon from FYBAMMC, Ms. Smita Kori from FY B.COM, Mr.Rathin Sawant from SYBMS and Ms. Anisha Khetwani from SYBAMMC. These panelists were accompanied by host Hrithika Prakash Sharma and the audience. The Team Studio handed over the virtual stage to the participants at 12:30 pm.

The Judges for this event were Professor Neena Sharma and Professor Sharanya Sanoj. The conversation was initiated by addressing the root cause of this issue. Some accused the Indian media for sensationalizing rape cases and some talked about the game of victim blaming by the Media. The Panelists proposed the idea of taking Bigger steps in order to curb this Rape culture. The panelists rightly ruled out the theories of Improper clothing, too much freedom, incorrect schooling of girls as the reason for rapes. Several solutions were also put forward by the participants. The audience tossed in some questions for the panelists which was brilliantly and rationally answered. Towards the ending everyone strongly agreed about Media's responsibility and significant role in shaping social and sensitive issues like Rapes. Before concluding the event the judges also enlightened the participants with their constructive opinions. Mr. Rathin Sawant from SYBMS and Ms. Saisaranyya Menon from FYBAMMC were presented with the award of Best Speakers for the session. The meet concluded with a note of self-realization and valuable perspectives.
