

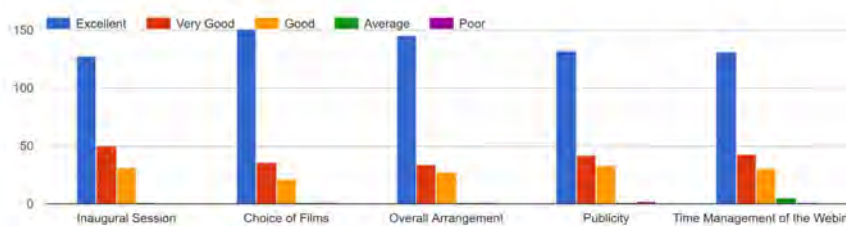

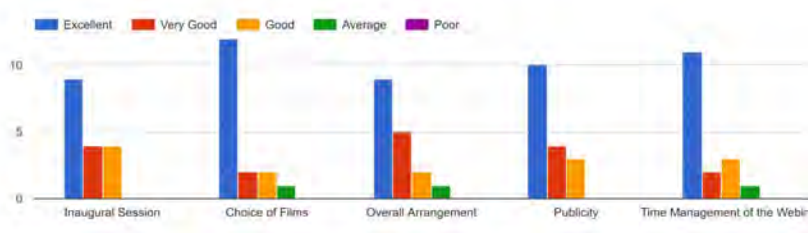

Report Samabhav 2022

The Internal Committee is a statutory body formed as per the provisions of the POSH Act. As part of gender sensitisation programme expected from the IC, it was decided to host Samabahav 2022, film fest curated by Mr. Harish Sadani, Executive Director, Men Against Violence and Abuse (MAVA). An open film festival would also serve as an outreach to students and the community in gender sensitisation. Internal Committee of S M Shetty College, Powai in collaboration with Men Against Violence and Abuse (MAVA) organised a two day international Film Festival-Samabhav 2022- on Gender Diversity and Inclusion on 11th and 12th March, 2022 in the college auditorium.

SamaBhav is a traveling International Film Festival organized by MAVA since 2017. It is a unique Film Festival on Gender Diversity, going across the length and breadth of India. 3 editions of the traveling film fest have engaged directly over 6000 University and College Youths, Civil Society Bodies' Members in 23 cities (2-tier & 3 -tier) and 12 districts across India. Thousands of youth participants have been engaged further via social media. SamaBhav is a unique, one of its kind Film Festival, as the specially curated films include regional, national and international shorts, features and documentaries covering a range of gender and sexuality themes: • Gender-based discrimination & violence against women, challenging misogyny, toxic Masculinity & Patriarchy LGBTQIA issues, homophobia & transphobia • Intersectionality • Gender binaries

The inaugural function of the film fest was held on 11th March in the presence of PEC Chairman Sri B.R.Shetty, Vice chairman Sri Ratnakar Shetty Mundkur, Secretary CA Jagdish Shetty and Treasurer CS Uttam Shetty. The function began with lighting the lamp followed by a prayer. This was followed by a welcome speech by Principal Dr.Sridhara Shetty.

Founder Director of MAVA Harish Sadani addressed the audience about the philosophy behind the fest and what he hopes to achieve with the fest.

Noted actor and producer Sonali Kulkarni graced the occasion. She spoke about the importance of acceptance of all diversities in society including gender diversity. She also commended the college for hosting the fest and mentioned that the students were privileged in that they had the opportunity to watch such film in their campus.

Chairman PEC Sri BR Shetty spoke about the need and importance of gender education and how the college strives to inculcate values of inclusion among its students.

Ms. Anna Lekvall, Consul General of Sweden Mumbai attended the function. She spoke about the importance Sweden gives to gender equality and how the consulate supports MAVA in its efforts to spread the message of equality and equity. She expressed her pleasure at the college's initiative to host a film fest on various gender issues.

Mr. Francis Paradis, Director and Consul, Quebec Government Office in Mumbai also graced the function with his presence. He emphasised on the need to bring gender issues to schools and colleges and to educate children at a young age about the values of diversity and inclusion.

Ms. Dnyaneshwari Talpade, Public Affairs, Culture and Education Advisor, Quebec Govt. Office, Mumbai, Neeraj Churi, Film Producer & Advisor, SamaBhav Film Fest, Zameer Kamble, Gender Rights Activist & Advisor, directors Arun Fulara, Lubna Yusuf, Shaan and Anukampa , Professor Sharmila Sreekumar from IIT Bombay were among the other attendees on Day 1.

The catalogue for the film fest was released by all dignitaries and distribute among all those present.

A total of 12 films were screened over two days from directors in India and abroad. All films were followed by discussions led by gender rights activists, social activists who were present on both days. Stimulating discussion, sharing of experiences enriched the fest.

On both days the screenings ran to packed audiences which included students and staff of SM Shetty college and sizable audience form other colleges (students and teachers), NGO members, Press members and other members of civil society.

A highlight of the first day was a play was performed by volunteers of MAVA, directed by Rasika Agashe. where they raise questions about important social concerns such as gender discrimination, verbal abuse, eve teasing, rape, and society's attitude toward transgender people, how all men are not created equal, women's virginity until marriage, and human rights

Maida is an eight-year-long living documentary film. It delves into the traditional conventions of dowry, child marriage, and the common habit of school dropouts with the onset of menstruation. Maida follows the hopes and goals of a young schoolgirl in a Bihar hamlet. She dispels the idea of women's empowerment as we know it through her storytelling and Bhojpuri folk songs. Such incidents go unreported due to a lack of bravery to face the societal implications. All laws, covenants, and policies fail at the implementation level, and girl children continue to be exploited in the absence of a voice of their own.

Ms Lubna Yusuf shared how she shot the film and the problems she faced, how she planned things, some worked out and some didn't. She interacted with the audience about the film and the idea behind it.

'Bhaap' portrays the harsh reality of the subtle normalization of domestic violence in the life of not one but many women living in India. Or Bhaap depicts the painful truth of the subtle normalisation of patriarchy in the lives of many Indian women.

It immerses the audience in the life of a middle-class housewife living in one of Mumbai's innumerable little spaces. In a series of seven shots, it not only shows the woman's fairly basic routine, but also alludes to a bigger social issue that persists beneath the surface, sexism in India.

After the movie, the lead in the film, Dipannita Banerjee described how she felt during the movie and the idea they want to share from the film.

DAY 2 – 12th March

Mr. Harish Sadani, Festival Founder and Director welcomed the audience to Day 2 of the Film Festival. Students and Professors from various colleges were present.

Metamorphosis a Bengali short film directed by Sankha. A little about the director was said including accomplishments and their journey in the film industry. 'Metamorphosis', his first feature-length documentary, has been mentored and pitched in Dhaka Doc Lab, Docedge Kolkata, and Good pitch India. It was screened in Yamagata, Docpoint Helsinki, and won Best Documentary Award at Kolkata International Film Festival. The screening of Metamorphosis began shortly after the synopsis was given.

Suvana, the protagonist of the film who is a transgender female was present at the festival online via zoom. After the film there was a Q&A session held with Suvana, the audience asked many questions about the LGBTQIA community, and spoke about her journey as a trans woman in India.

Black Roses and Red Dresses

The next film in order was the short film Black Roses and Red Dresses, the introduction was given by Mr. Harish Sadani followed by the introduction of the Director by the host. Black Roses and Red Dresses is a Hindi Short film directed by Shirley Abraham, she is a Cannes prize-winning documentary filmmaker and a member of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. The short film was about acid attack survivors who write letters to their attackers as a process of healing and confronting their fears. The movie was screened shortly after the synopsis was given.

Roopa and Ritu, acid attack survivors joined online via zoom, they answered audience questions about their difficulties, trials, tribulations, and eventually the triumphs.

The Great Indian Kitchen

The next film in line was 'The Great Indian Kitchen' directed by Joe Baby. The host spoke about the director Joe Baby is a Film Director, scriptwriter, and actor who works in the Malayalam Film Industry. He made his directorial movie debut through the movie '2 Penkuttikal' released in 2016. His fourth film 'The Great Indian Kitchen' was directly released over the 'NeeStream' OTT platform on 15 January 2021. With a positive response around the globe, the movie was officially released on Amazon Prime Video. It was screened at UK Asian Film Festival and won the 'Making Waves Digitally' Award and 'Equality in Cinema' Award from Melbourne International Film Festival. The movie also won 3 awards at the 51st Kerala State Film Awards including Best Film, Best Screenplay, and Best Sound Design. The Great Indian Kitchen is a startling, scathing, stunning take-down of patriarchy and its eternal sidekick, religion. That Joe Baby achieves so much with the simplest of stories, one that has been staring us all in the face all our lives, is what makes it such a work of genius.

The discussion followed by the movie was insightful. What happens when women are pushed to the edge by a society plagued with patriarchy, ritualism, and dogmatism were all discussed in detail.

Sakhya

The next film was 'Sakhya'. Sakhya is a film about a mother. Compromise and conformism are the ideas we associate with mothers. With their dreams lost to the people around them, we rarely see them subjectively.

This is a film about one such mother. With two kids and a working husband, Asha is a simple middle-class housewife. Thirty-four years old, she's just coming to terms with the inertness of her daily routine. In the bustling city, Asha lives a monotonous life within the four walls of her house. Her simple wish to have someone to talk to remains unfulfilled until new neighbors arrive. This film is directed by Kunika, Kunika is a Master's Graduate from the National Institute of Design (NID) in Film and Video communication. She has always enjoyed storytelling and believes films are strong mediums of telling stories as you can recreate reality and capture it forever. She is deeply interested in exploring stories rooted in human behavior, family, and home. She is currently employed as a Promo Producer at Prime Focus Technology for Disney Asia Pacific. She was present at the film festival and gave the audience a lot of insights into filmmaking. 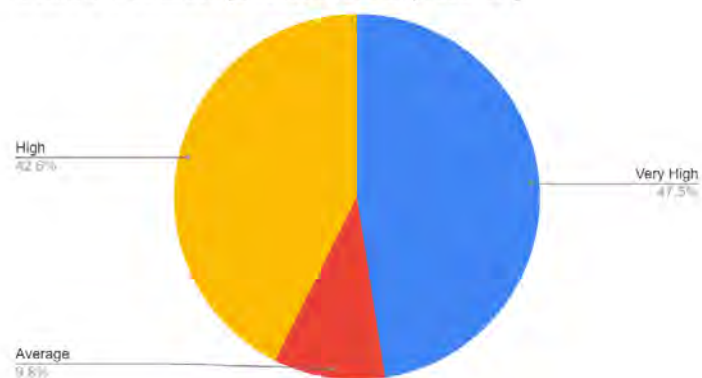

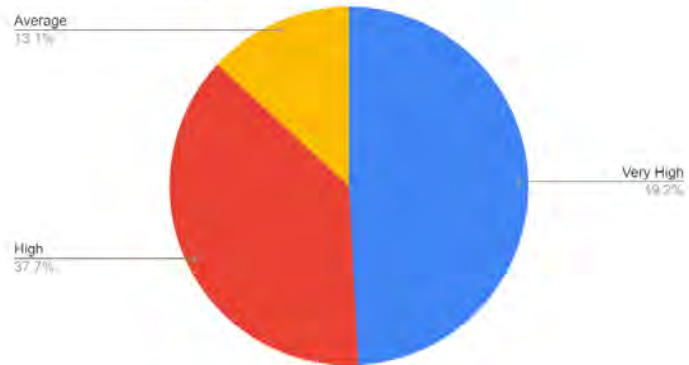

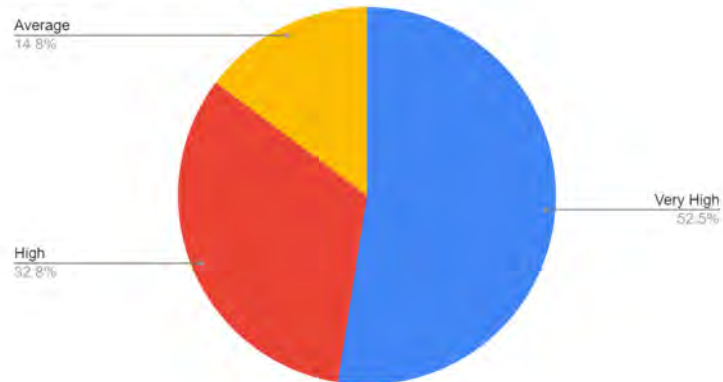
Count of Feedback [Effectiveness of presenter]



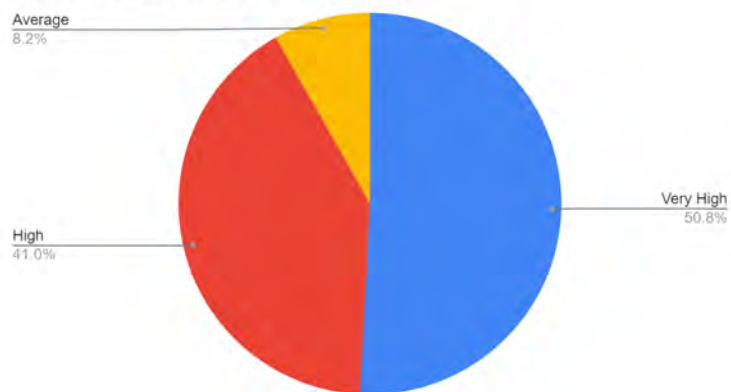
Count of Feedback [Content Relevance]



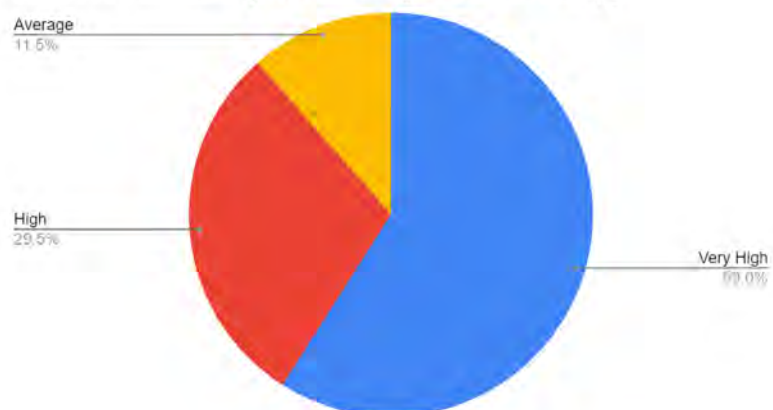
Count of Feedback [Video Quality]



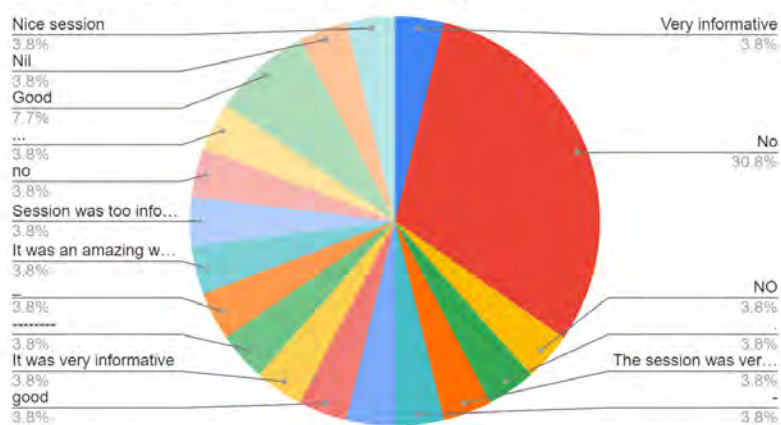
Count of Feedback [Audio Quality]
