Report of Collaboration

The BMM/BAMMC Department of Bunts Sangha's S.M.Shetty College of Science, Commerce & Management Studies – Powai, organized an Outreach Program at 12:00pm on 25th January, 2021 , 4th February 2021 and on 5th February 2021 via aZoom Meeting. The attendees were our Bmm students along with faculty members –Prof. Neena Sharma and Prof. Sharanya Sanoj. The event was hosted by our Department Coordinator Prof. Kalpana Rai Menon.





Our Guests for the day were Mr. Arun Rai and Mr. Brijesh Kumar Maurya with theirstudents from Sonbhadra, Uttar Pradesh.



Commencing the interaction, our Prof. Kalpana Rai Menon spoke with the teachers of the Composite school Barkhohara, Uttar Pradesh. It was a pleasure having had a chance to interact with the children. The young students were from the 5th and 6th standards. The experiences of their living and schooling were shared. Additionally, they were also excited to see us and expressed a deep interest in meeting us. Our department students interacted with them. Mr. Nishal from BAMMC also performed adance for them. Other students from the department had shown them videos of a beach and high-rise buildings as per their requests. The curious students also asked questions about the unfamiliar city life.





Prof. Neena Sharma took the initiative of questioning them on their plans for the future and what they would like to become. While students showed interest in wanting to study more, some also bravely mentioned their dreams of wanting to become doctors. The little children were also shown a video of our college and its infrastructure to make them aware of what a city school looks like.





While speaking about dreams and ambitions, the child dream also touched the topic -prevalence of gender discrimination in their

surroundings. Post that, they performed a song for the class and they also brought along with them their handmade mud toys toshow the meeting.

The other topics discussed in outreach programme were:

- 1) Rain water harvesting, kids were taught the basic and easy process of rainwater harvesting.
- 2) Videos related to face painting were shown to them.
- 3) Availability of freshwater, their living, etc was also discussed.
- 4)The kids made toys out of soil, they were asked about their interests and hobbies





The interaction in all sessions were overall very successful and the interaction between the students and our department never saw a dull moment.
