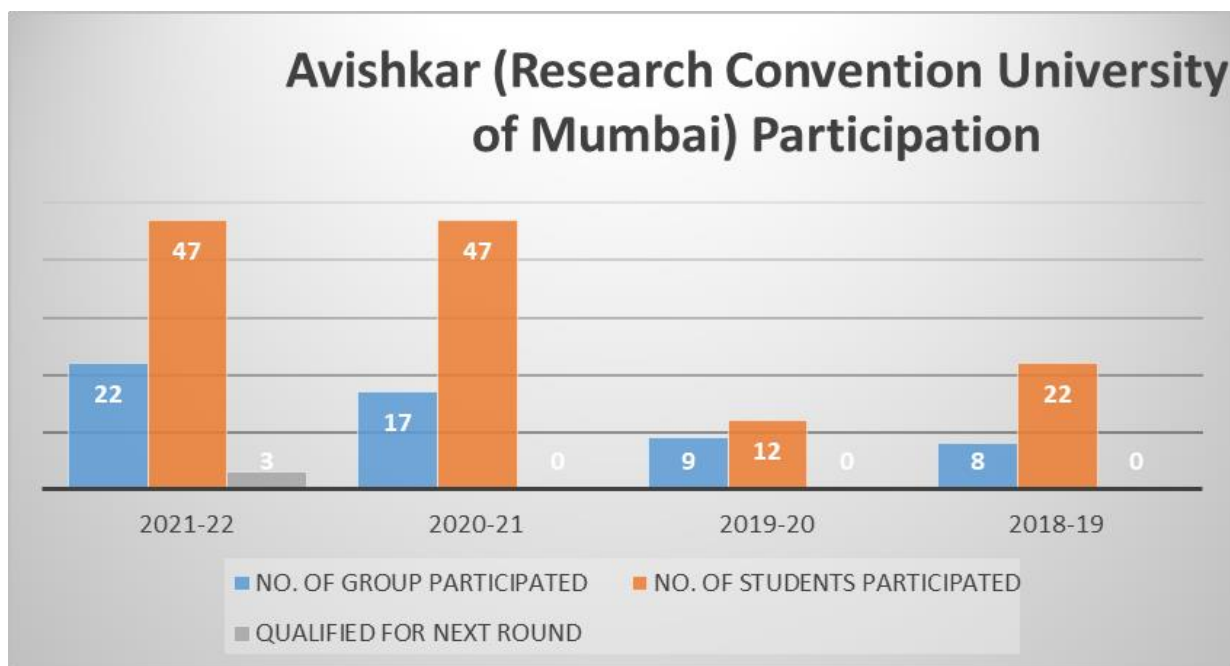
### **AVISHKAR - RESEARCH CONVENTION 2018-19**

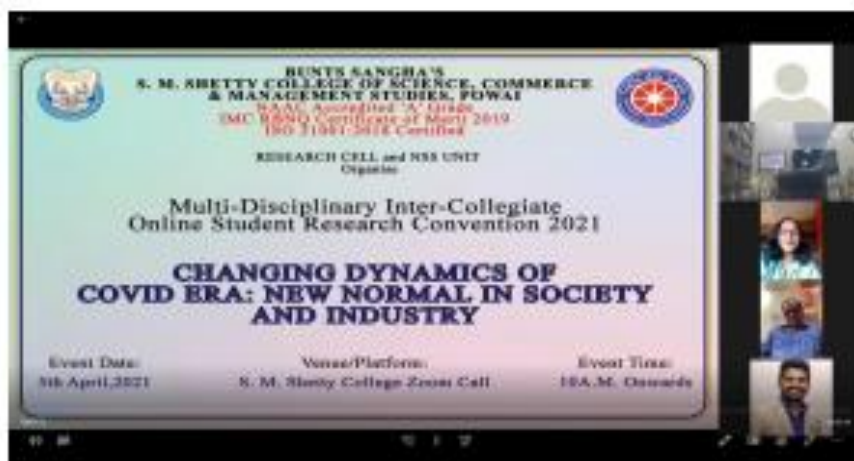

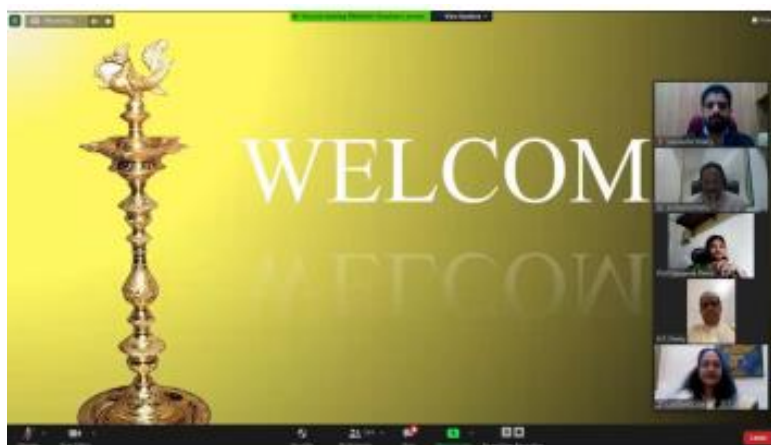

Dr. Liji Santosh, Vice Principal and IQAC Coordinator gave the Vote of Thanks.

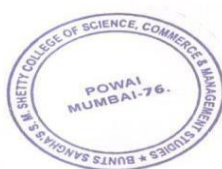
Total 75+ research papers were received out of which 68 were selected. In total 441 students were participants present during the inauguration.

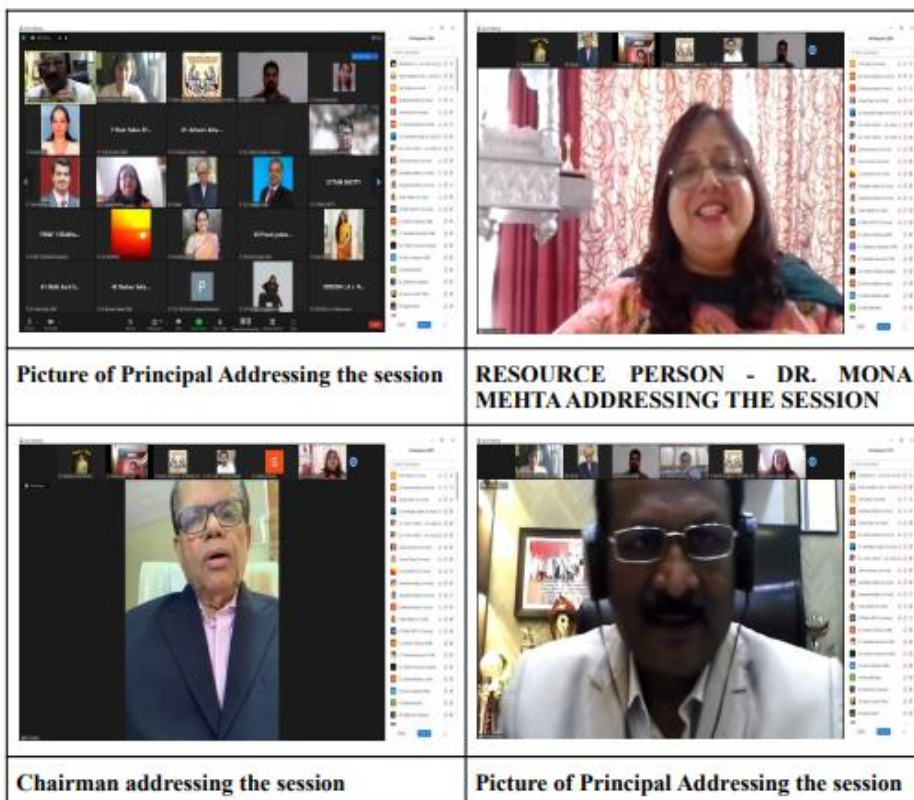

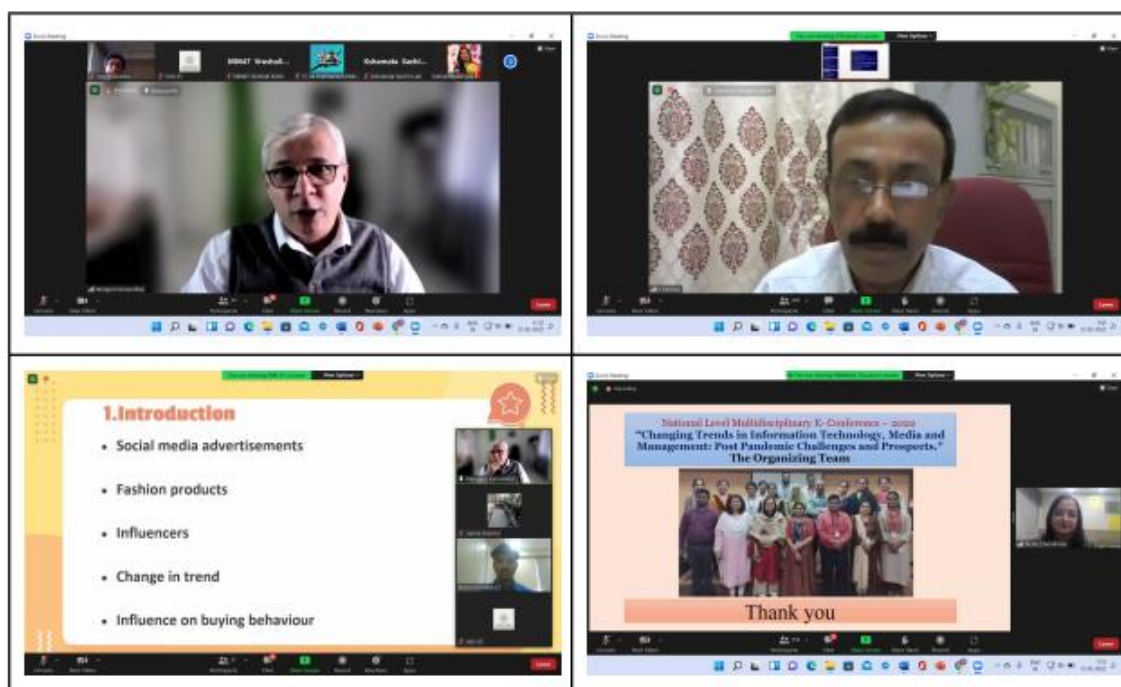

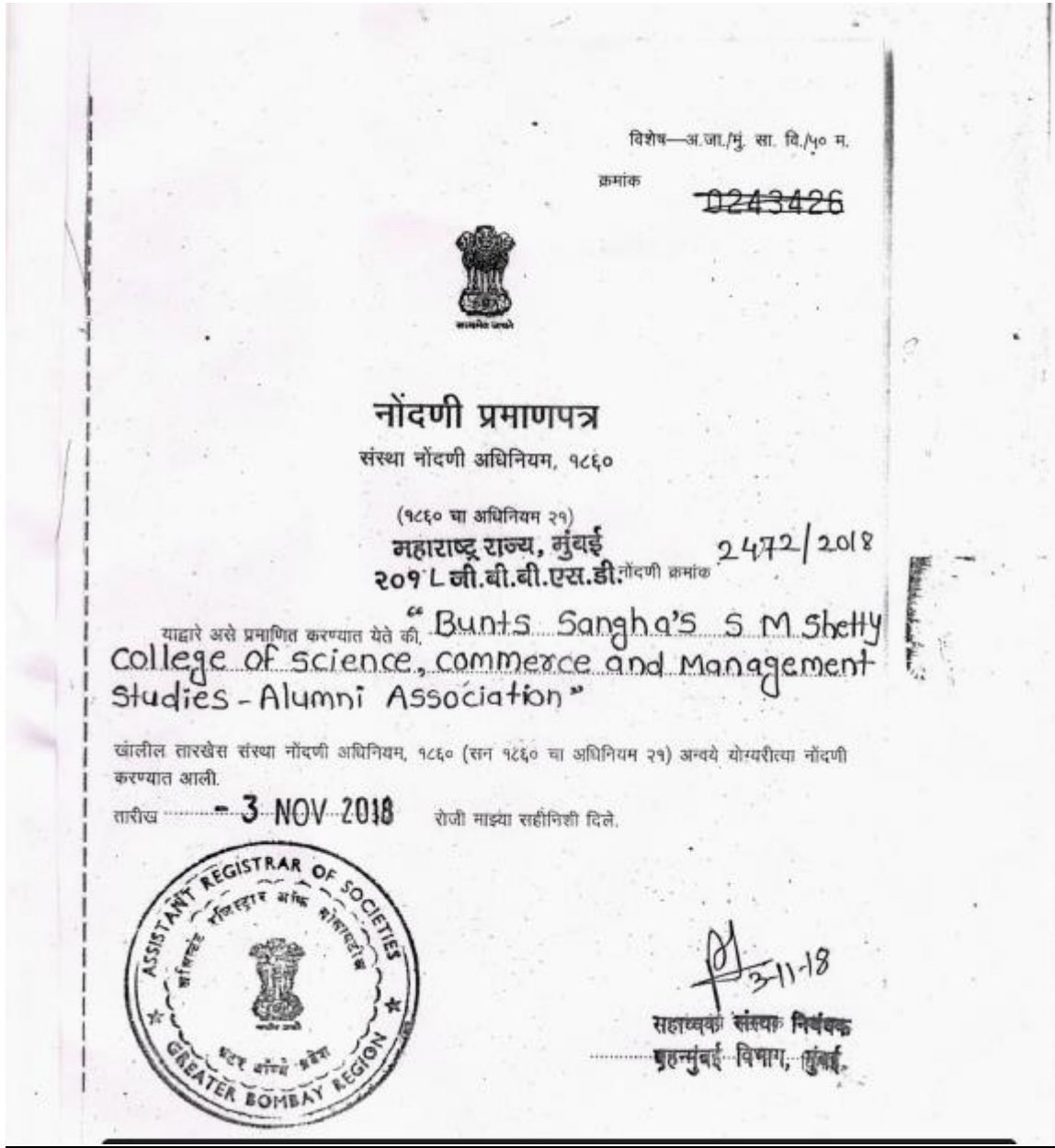






# Alumni

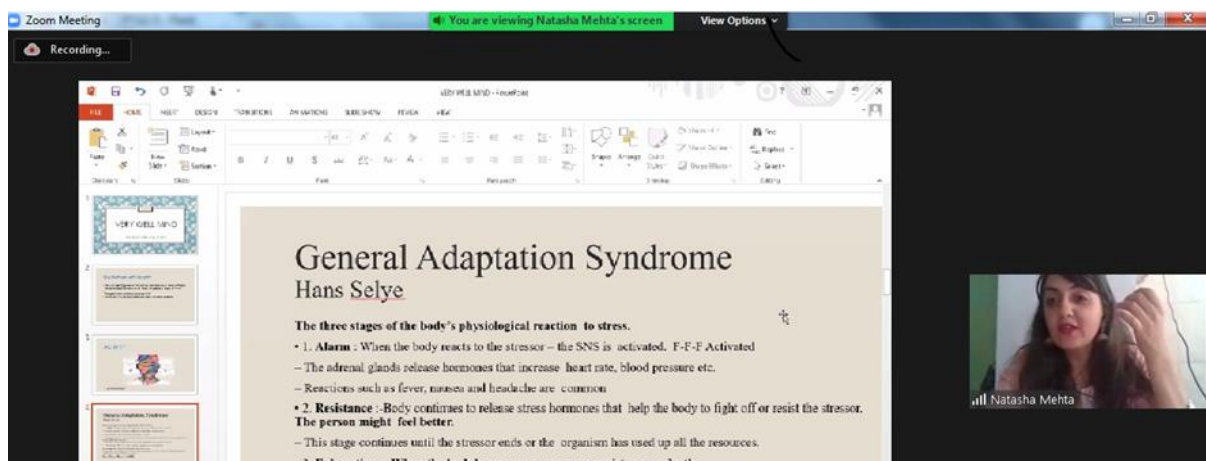
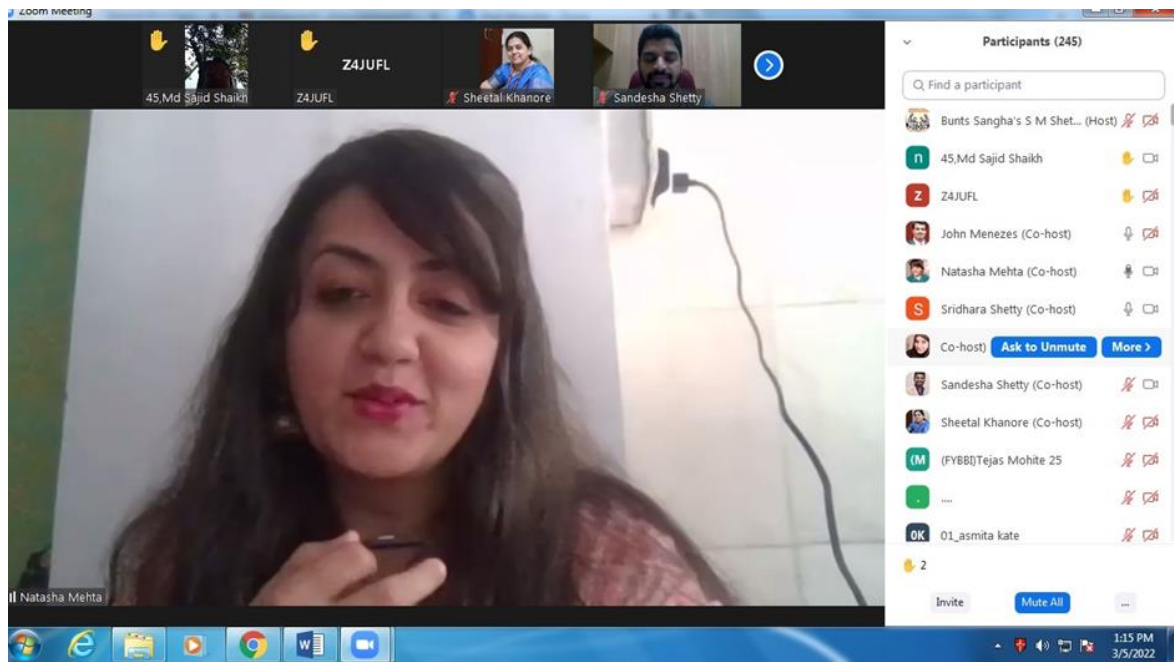
