Principal Dr. Sridhara Shetty welcomed the guest by felicitating him and he also addressed the




Collage Competition was judged by Mr. Ganesh Shetty and Mr. Rahul Shirke.





The visit was truly very informative and educative wherein the students made utmost utilization of the opportunity to sharpen their analytical skills.



SYBMS (A) – EVENT MANAGEMT AND IMC ACTIVITY

Under the courses: Event Marketing and IMC, an activity was conducted for the students for SY BMS (A). For their assignment; students were instructed to organize an event for the students of the college. Objective of the study was to make students understand the practicality and applicability of the event management concepts that they learn throughout the course.

From the class strength of 61 students, three groups were made consisting of 20, 20 and 21 students each. Students were supposed to pick a product that they want to endorse or promote through their event. Type of event should be appropriate enough to compliment the nature of product promoted and demography of the attendee base (students and teachers). All the students of each group contributed Rs 150 each; which became their budget to organize the event. Students started right from deciding the product, naming the product, deciding the type of event, naming the event, marketing of product and the event, designing and displaying posters, promotion on social media and other means, arranging any raw material and supporting accessories they require for food preparation and games management. On three different allotted dates, each team carried out the event on the 7th floor common area of the college.

Every activity/aspect related to Event management and marketing was assessed under Event Marketing course by Prof. Prachi Agarwal whereas all the activities related to marketing of products and events were assessed under IMC course by Prof. Vijay Vishwakrma. On the respective date of their event, each team was given 1.5 hours (10:30 am – 12 pm) for the preparation of event and then the team conducted the event from 12 pm to 1:30 pm.

Three groups picked three different food products i.e. Bread, popcorn and cheese rolls with Event names as 'DejaVu', 'Just Pop'd' and 'Foodelico' respectively. In the events, students organized various fun games, movie for students and teachers along with their food product. Team issued tickets to students to buy food and participate in the games. Whatever the amount they collected was counted as their revenue from the event. All the teams successfully covered their cost and earned the profit (which was distributed among the team members). Students were also responsible for maintain the discipline during the event, taking feedback from attendees and clearing the venue post event.
