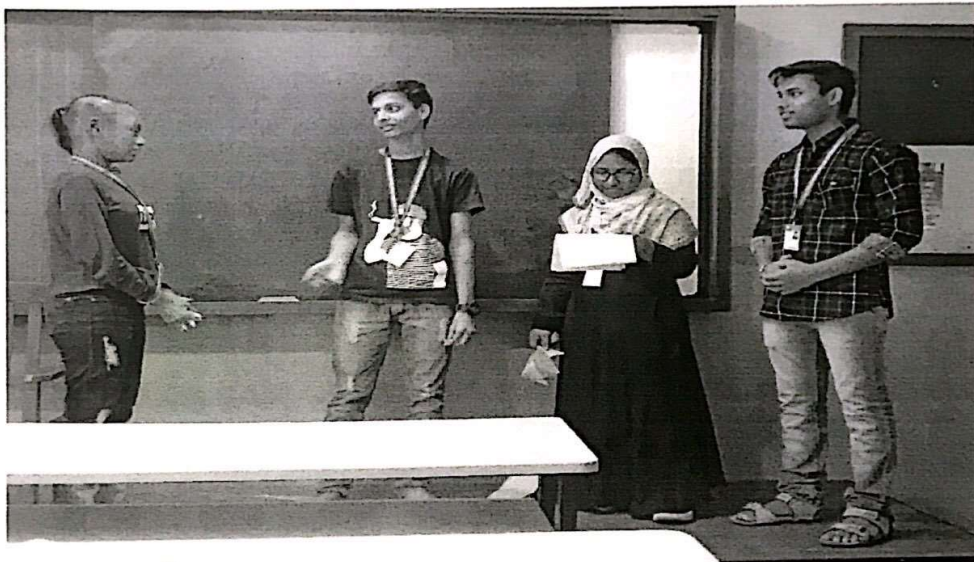

Objective - To enhance English speaking skills of students who find it difficult to articulate in English

Report:

A Spoken English Course was conducted from 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019 to 18<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to enhance the English speaking skills of students. The duration of the course was two hours per day.

A syllabus was created with different activities which involved activities in speaking. The classes were conducted by Prof. Kalpana Rai Menon, Prof. Darpana Manjarekar, Prof. Shaoli Mistry, and Prof. Neena Sharma.

The collective skills gained helped the students to stage a short play in English.

Twenty students from all departments attended the course of which ten students were found eligible for certification.
