The forum was then open for students and parents to ask any more questions, the same were answered by the faculty members.



Was the information provided by the class in-charges useful? 101 responses




Were your queries handled efficiently?



Do you think activities conducted in class are improving your ward's skills? 101 responses




Do you think the syllabus designed by the University is satisfactory? 101 responses
