**Points discussed in the meeting:**


The date of the event was decided as 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2019.

**REPORT ON ONAM DAY CELEBRATION**



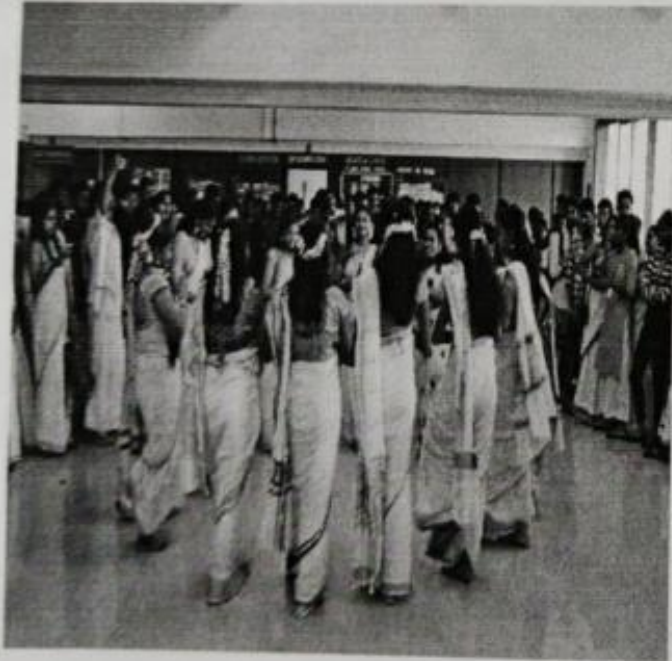

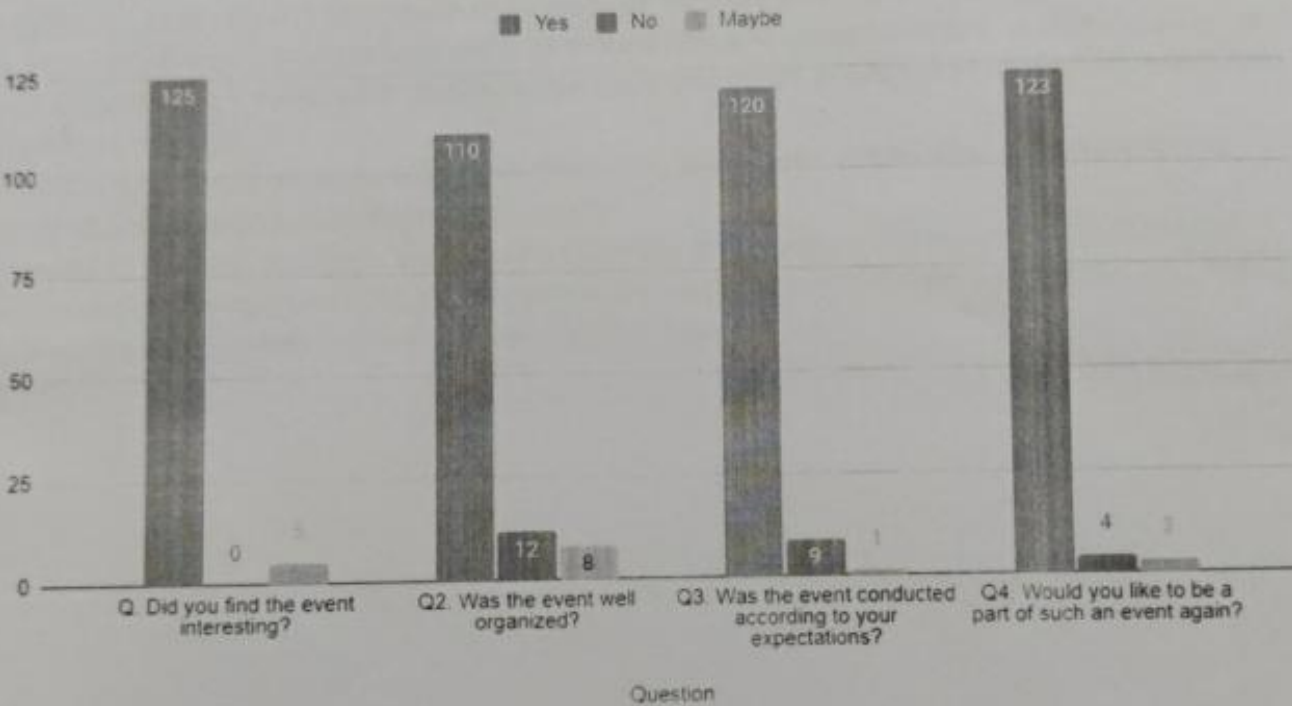
