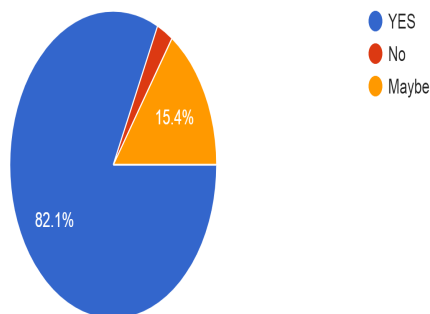

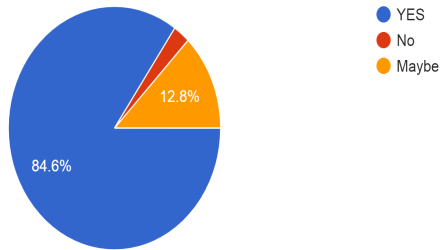
Do you like the theme of this competition?

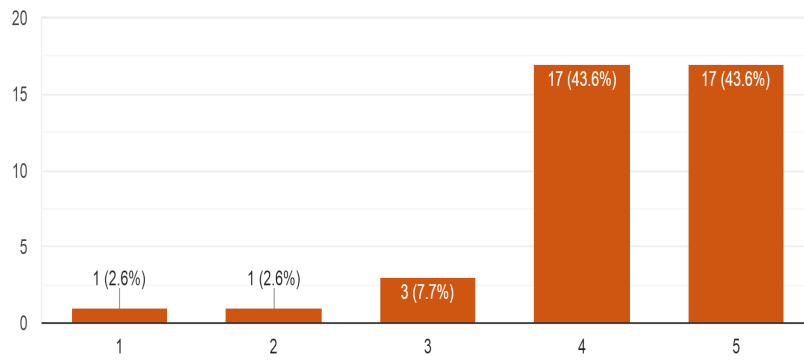
